### Website section relating to personal data

#### PERSONAL DATA PROTECTION POLICY

*This policy may be modified by RUBIS TERMINAL at any time. You are therefore asked to check it regularly. Last modified on 18/02/2021.*

The purpose of this notice is to describe the way in which RUBIS TERMINAL (hereinafter referred to as the “**Company**”) processes the personal data collected when you use the website [www.rubis-terminal.com](http://www.rubis-terminal.com) (hereinafter referred to as the “**Website**”) and to inform you of the rights conferred on you by the regulations on the protection of this data.

In accordance with the regulations applicable to personal data protection, the Company is the “controller”.

“Personal data” designates any information likely to identify you. You can be identified directly or indirectly, from a single item of data, or from the combination of a set of data items.

You are likely to provide us with a certain amount of personal data (such as your surname(s), first name(s), e-mail address, telephone number, fax number, State of residence, company name and position), when:

- you register on the Website’s Investors Space ([www.rubis-terminal.com/log-in/?lang=fr](http://www.rubis-terminal.com/log-in/?lang=fr));
- you complete and send us the contact form available on the Website ([www.rubis-terminal.com/nous-contacter](http://www.rubis-terminal.com/nous-contacter)).

The mandatory fields in our online forms are marked with an asterisk. If the mandatory questions are not answered, we will not be able to provide you with the service(s) requested.

You have the right to withdraw your consent at any time, without this calling into question any processing carried out prior to this point:

- by writing to us at the following address: RUBIS TERMINAL – Service juridique – 33, avenue de Wagram, 75017 PARIS;
- or by contacting us using the aforementioned contact form ([www.rubis-terminal.com/nous-contacter](http://www.rubis-terminal.com/nous-contacter)).

Your personal data will subsequently not be processed in a way that is incompatible with the purposes set out above. Your data is kept for the period necessary for the purpose of the processing, namely while you are registered on the Website’s Investors Space or while contact remains active.

In the event you unsubscribe from the Investors Space, your personal data will come to be deleted within a period of two (2) years. In the event contact becomes inactive, your personal data will come to be deleted within a period of five (5) years, as of the last contact.

In order to offer you a better service, the Company establishes Website statistics and audience reports. In order to permit statistical analysis, the Company uses the Google Analytics services, by installing cookies (small text files stored by the browser on the user's device) after you give your consent. The data generated using Google Analytics is processed and stored by the Company and Google Analytics only. The data is processed in accordance with the regulations on personal data protection.

A window displays automatically on your first connection to the Website and details the types of cookies installed and allows you to select those to which you consent for use. The cookies are temporarily kept, i.e. as long as your browser session is open. You can object to cookies being saved (however, their non-installation may limit some of the Website functions). The browser tool configuration for this purpose has been described by the *Commission Nationale de l'Informatique et des Libertés* (CNIL = French Data Protection Agency), at the following address: <https://www.cnil.fr/fr/cookies-les-outils-pour-les-maitriser>.

The personal data collected is processed by the Company or, where applicable, by a service provider obligated contractually to comply with the confidentiality and security thereof, and to only use this for the purposes of the assignment entrusted to it. The Company undertakes not to sell, hire or transfer this to third parties.

Any transfer of personal data to a third country outside the European Economic Area is made in compliance with the applicable regulations and in such a way as to ensure suitable protection for the data.

The Company implements suitable measures to maintain the security, confidentiality and integrity of the personal data collected and, in particular, to prevent this from being altered, damaged or accessed by unauthorized third parties.

In accordance with the personal data regulations, you have a right to access, to rectification, to erasure, to restriction of processing, to portability and to object, as well as the right to establish guidelines for the fate of your personal data after your death.
